

Brief Summaries of Old Testament Texts on the Abolishing of the Ceremonial Law

1. Genesis 49 - “until Shiloh come”
2. Deuteronomy 18 - a prophet like Moses is to come
3. Psalm 2 - God’s Son, the coming king, on Mt. Zion
4. Psalm 40 - One who comes instead of sacrifices and burnt offerings
5. Psalm 110 - the priest forever after the order of Melchizedek
6. Isaiah 2 - prophecy of the exaltation of the temple mount with nations flowing up to it
7. Isaiah 19 - prophecy of an altar, pillar, etc., in Egypt
8. Isaiah 53 - prophecy of the suffering servant who is a trespass offering
9. Isaiah 61 - God’s anointed servant will come and preach the jubilee year of liberty
10. Isaiah 66 - prophesies a time when Gentiles will be priests and Levites
11. Jeremiah 3 - there will come a day when people will no more remember the ark of the covenant
12. Jeremiah 31 - the “new covenant”
13. Jeremiah 33 - there will always be priests and Levites, and they will be as numerous as the stars of heaven and the sand on the sea shore
14. Daniel 9 - the Messiah will be cut off to deal with sin, iniquity and transgression
15. Jonah - the salvation of Nineveh (Gentiles), yet circumcision, temple, sacrifices and pilgrimage are not required (?)
16. Zechariah 3 - the Branch who is both priest and king is coming, and iniquity will be removed in one day
17. Zechariah 6 - the Branch who is both priest and king is coming, and a temple will be built for the Gentiles
18. Zechariah 13 - “In that day there shall be a fountain ... for sin and for uncleanness”
19. Zechariah 14 - every pot in Jerusalem will be holy to the Lord and the bells of the horses will have “holiness unto the Lord” inscribed on them
20. Malachi 1 - incense and pure offering will be offered to the Lord all around the world
21. Malachi 3 - the Messenger of the Covenant (preceded by His messenger) purifies the sons of Levi so that they offer righteous sacrifices
22. Malachi 4 - keep the law of Moses until Elijah comes!
