For we know that the law is spiritual: (14a) I consent unto the law that it is good. (16b)	but I am carnal, sold under sin. (14b) For that which I do I allow not: (15a) for what I would, that do I not; (15b) but what I hate, that do I. (15c) If then I do that which I would not, (16a) Now then it is no more I that do it (17a) but sin that dwelleth in me. (17b) For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh,) dwelleth no good thing: (18a) but how to perform that which is good I find not. (18c) For the good that I would I do not: (19a) but the evil which I would not, that I do. (19b) Now if I do that I would not, (20a) it is no more I that do it, (20b) but sin that dwelleth in me. (20c) evil is present with me. (21b) But I see another law in my members, (23a) warring against the law of my mind, (23b) and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members. (24b)	for to will is present with me; (18b) I find then a law, that, when I would do good, (21a) For I delight in the law of God after the inward man: (22) I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. (25a) So then with the mind I myself serve the law of God; (25b)
