- A. The two masters
 - 1. The bad master
 - a. Sin (2, 6, 7, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 16, 17, 20, 22)
 - b. Law (14, 15)
 - c. Death (9)
 - 2. The good master
 - a. God (10, 11, 13, 13, 22)
 - b. Grace (14, 15)
 - c. Obedience, righteousness and holiness (16, 18, 19, 20)
- B. The preposition characterizing the position of each person with regard to his/her spiritual master
 - 1. Under
 - 2. 4 times (14, 14, 15, 15)
- C. The spiritual masters' relationship to those under them
 - 1. Dominion (9, 14; cf. 7:1)
 - 2. Reign (12; cf. 5:14, 21, 21)
- D. The person's relationship to the reign or dominion of the spiritual master he/she is under
 - 1. Servant/slave (16, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 22)
 - 2. Cf. bound (7:2) and held (7:6)
- E. The person's relationship to the reign or dominion of the spiritual master he/she is not under
 - 1. Free (7, 18, 20, 22; cf. 7:3)
 - 2. Cf. loosed (7:2) and delivered (7:6)
