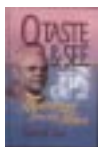

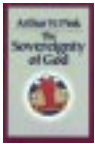

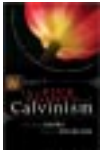

Abraham, the Father of the Faithful

£15/set

16 sermons on the life of Abraham (Gen. 12-25) emphasising his role as “the father of all them that believe” (Rom. 4:11) and dealing with the covenant, the promise, the land, faith, justification, Lot, Melchizedek, Ishmael, Abimelech, “The Burial of Sarah,” “A Bride for Isaac,” etc.

God’s Covenant and the Golden Calf

£8/set

9 sermons on Exodus 32-34 including treatments of Israel’s idolatry, Moses’ breaking the tables of stone, the faithfulness of the sons of Levi, Moses’ shining face and God’s revealing His glory.

David, the Man After God’s Own Heart

£10/set

The Most Avoided Chapter in the Bible

After listening to these 7 sermons on eternal election and reprobation, including "God's Hatred of Esau," you will understand why Romans 9 is "The Most Avoided Chapter in the Bible."

Church Discipline, a Key of the Kingdom of Heaven

£4/set

5 sermons on church discipline and excommunication (I Cor. 5), a subject little known and widely ignored, showing how "a little leaven leaveneth the whole lump."

Christian Singleness and Marriage

£10/set

11 sermons on marriage and the goodness and danger of singleness, including "The Duty of Sex in Marriage," "Married to an Unbeliever" and "The Cares of Marriage" (I Cor. 7).

Christian Love

£12/set
